

SERVICES AREAS & INTERNSHIPS

Firefly offers rolling positions to individuals seeking internships or practicums. Our wide range of services and locations across the state create many opportunities to learn and serve. Information on each program area can be found below. Degree type requirements vary by program. All internships require applicants be a minimum of 21 years of age.

Associate or bachelor's degree in process

Community Partners for Child Safety (CPCS) | A voluntary, free program for families to help them identify and work towards their specific goals by using resources in their community.

Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) | A program that assists low-income families access quality child care and education.

Adoption Services | Conducting home studies, background checks, and providing support and training throughout the adoption process. Available in all counties.

Family Resource Centers (FRCs) | Centers for support and community to families and parents. Our Community Navigators provide case management to families, connect them to local resources and programming, and provide parent education and support. There are also co-located services on site, such as Susy's Store, which provides safety supplies to families.

Associate, bachelor's, or master's degree in process

Home-Based Services | A set of services designed to help youth and adults while they have an open DCS case. Available services include Family Preservation, Case Management, Home-Based Therapy, Fatherhood Engagement, Supervised Visitation, and more, depending on location.

Older Youth Services (OYS) | Services for young people who are aging out of foster care. We provide financial and emotional support to guide them to independence.

Survivor Advocacy | Free and confidential support to survivors of assault and abuse. Our advocates can help survivors at any stage in the healing process. This may include emotional support, court advocacy, safety planning, and referrals to community resources.

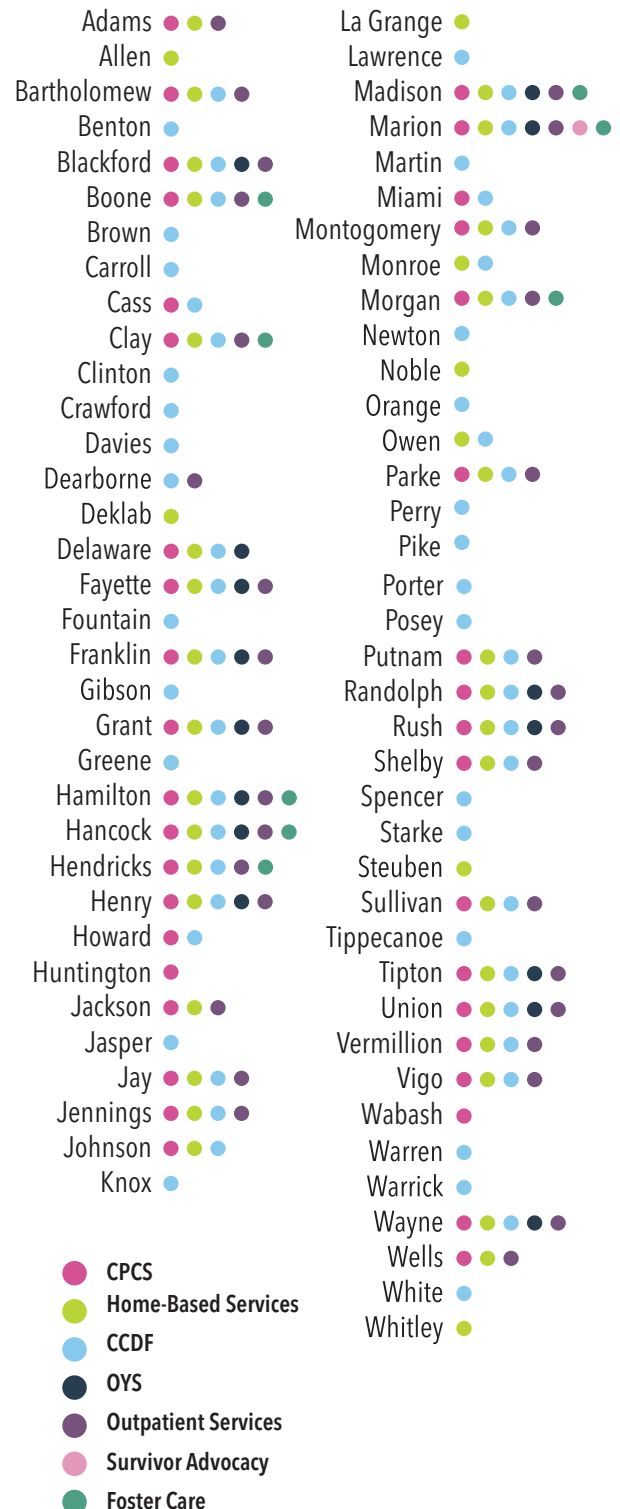
Foster Care | Comprehensive services for foster care parents and children, including training, case management, and counseling.

Children's Shelter | Located within the Gene Glick Family Support Center, the shelter offers short-term housing to youth in Indianapolis and central Indiana in crisis. Programming for youth in the shelter utilizes the Teaching-Family Model, addressing trauma and equipping children with effective coping skills.

Outpatient Services | Supporting individuals and families through life's challenges and changes. We offer services in a variety of areas, including Substance Use Treatment, Anger Management, Survivor Counseling, Batterers Intervention, and Mental Health Counseling.

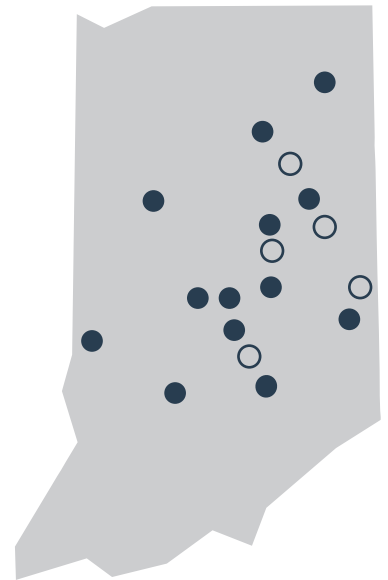
